Declaration of RoHS Compliance and on WEEE Directive

Dear Sir or Madam,

The directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-II, Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances) restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. eddylab GmbH is globally active as a manufacturer of sensor technology. The protection of the environment and natural resources is one of our corporate principles, which is why it is a matter of course for us to comply with the environmental objectives of Directive 2011/65/EU. This also includes the extension 2015/863/EU (RoHS-3), which since 22.06.2019 includes an amendment to Annex II of Directive 2011/65/EU.

We can hereby confirm the conformity of our products according to RoHS 2011/65/EU (RoHS-II) and 2015/863/EU (RoHS-3).

Directive No 2002/96/EC (known as WEEE or Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment) is aimed at reducing the amount of electronic scrap and to promote reutilization and environmental-friendly recycling. Directive No 2002/95/EC (RoHS I) and the WEEE Directive were together transposed into German law by the Electro and Electronic Equipment Act (ElektroG). According to the WEEE Directive, fixed installations or their components as well as prefabricated parts that do not represent independent units do not fall under its scope. Our products satisfy at least one of the above mentioned criteria and are therefore exempt from the WEEE Directive. For this reason, we are currently not planning any product labelling or registration with EAR, the national register for waste electric equipment.
